QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

1. What does wind look like?
2. What would happen if there wasn't any wind?
3. How is the Holy Spirit like wind?

GOING DEEPER

4. Read John 3:1-2. Why does Nicodemus come to Jesus by night? How can you know that someone is from God?
5. Read John 3:3-4. Did you choose to be born? Can you choose to be born again? What do you think of Nicodemus' question to Jesus after Jesus says you must be born again?
6. Read John 3:5-7. What is required to enter the kingdom of God? How are water and the Spirit connected? Have you experienced water and the Spirit together? What do you think is meant by "born of the flesh is flesh, born of the Spirit is spirit."?
7. Read John 3:8. How is someone born of the Spirit?
8. Read John 3:9-12. What does Nicodemus find so perplexing? Are we saved by what we do (keeping the law of Moses and traditions, as the Pharisees believe)?
9. Read John 3:13-15. Then read Numbers 21:9. What is Jesus saying here? How do we acquire eternal life?

10. Read John 3:16-17. These verses are nicknamed the "Gospel in a Nutshell."
Why do you think that is?
